Dear Families,

It is our pleasure to announce to you that DNA Prep Academy is gearing up for the Fall semester and taking its elite sports development development program and creating an exciting summer experience incoming and interested students in grades 5-8. Students in grades 5-8 will participate in our half-day Back-To-School Camp which will serve as a summer bridge, and provide a preview of DNA Prep Academy's Fall 2022 academic programming. Students will get an early start to the new school year by beginning to create reliable time personalized systems for time management and organization, and familiarizing themselves with foundational skills and habits of mind, required to be successful throughout the school year. During this time, students will be assessed, personal learning plans developed, and key academic areas will be targeted to address areas of weakness for grade level success— providing each student exactly what they need to catch up, keep up, and get ahead. Students will connect with fellow classmates and faculty, and acquaint themselves with campus life and relevant on-site amenities.

- DNA's Summer Bridge is a 4-week program and begins Monday, July 11th, and will continue through Friday, August 5th.
- The hours of the camp are 10:00AM to 2:00PM (Drop-off starts at 9:30AM and Last Pickup is 2:30 PM).

Registration is on a first come, first served basis and ends June 25th. The cost is \$100 per week for non-enrolled students and \$50 per week for enrolled DNA students (must pay for the full week) and the registration, T-shirt fee and all the weeks' tuition payments are due at the time of registration and are ALL NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE. Please note that once you register for our camp, you are liable for the tuition in full for all the weeks that you sign up for regardless of whether or not you use your reserved space. Staff are hired based on enrollment at the time of registration. NO CREDITS OR MAKE-UP DAYS WILL BE ISSUED FOR MISSED DAYS. Be aware that you are responsible to pay for the weeks that you sign up for whether you use them or not and you must sign up for a minimum of 2 weeks. Camp is subject to cancellation if low participation.

Hello Families,

Our countdown to summer has begun and we are looking forward to an exciting summer filled with exciting and unique experiences with all of our campers! Our goal is that each camper have a safe, exciting, and personally rewarding time creating life-long memories during DNA Prep Academy Summer programs. Following are some items that will help you and your camper get the best and safest experience from camp:

1. Lunch and Snack- Campers must bring a lunch and snack from home each day.
2. Please do not send any glass bottles or containers. In addition, please make sure your child has a nutritious morning snack before coming to camp each day. Additional snacks will be available for purchase at our camp office for \$1 each.
3. Water Play Days- On Fridays, we have our water play days. These days will involve water games and your camper may get soaked. For this day your camper may wear bathing suit or extra clothes to get wet in. Please send a towel and a change of clothes on these days.
4. Footwear- It is recommended that all footwears be close-toed for your camper's protection. Water shoes (not flip flops) are recommended for water play days on campus (on the grass).
5. Delinquent Accounts- A camper may not attend camp unless tuition is current. There are no exceptions to this rule. Tuition must be paid in advance by Friday of the coming week.
6. Medication - All medication must be in its original container and given to an office staff member on arrival. All efforts will be made to give medication at the required times. Campers may not self-medicate.
7. Discipline is important and we care about harmony and respect within our camp. Fighting, stealing, bullying, disrespectfulness to authority, inappropriate language, and vandalism to camp/school or another child's property will be brought to the attention of the camper's parents or guardians. Continued negative behavior may result in suspension or expulsion from camp.
8. FEES, etc.- Schedule changes are subject to a \$20.00 fee, per change. Schedule changes made with less than a two-week written notice will not be credited. There is a \$40 fee for each returned payment. Campers will not be able to attend camp until the account is current.
9. Illness- There are no adjustments in tuition charges due to an absence, and there are no make-up days. Illness can include isolation/quarantine due to COVID-19 infection or exposure.

10. Money- The camp is not responsible for any lost or stolen funds brought to the camp by the camper.
11. Personal Electronics- Laptops, electronic games (e.g., gaming consoles), tablets, headphones, etc. are not allowed at camp. These items pose distractions to the program and, often, dissention between campers. Campers who carry a cell phone may not use it to listen to music, watch videos, and access the internet or chat/text with friends. It may be used for parent/guardian contact only (with staff permission) and must be in a bag/backpack at all other times. The camp/school is not responsible for any lost or broken personal items.
12. Sun Protection- Please send sunblock to camp with your camper. They will have multiple opportunities to re-apply it during the day. Feel free to also include a hat and sunglasses, as we do have days that we will be doing activities outdoors.
13. Your camper's name MUST be on ALL belongings. This includes, sunscreen, towels, hats, clothing (we change clothes on water days, etc.), lunch bags and boxes, water bottles, shoes, sweaters, etc. Unmarked items are kept for one week only.

**THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT IS A BINDING LEGAL CONTRACT, PLEASE READ ALL PAGES CAREFULLY BEFORE
SIGNING.**

We know that playing sports and athletic training, and the events and activities related to them, are inherently risky, hazardous and dangerous activities, in which we choose to voluntarily participate at our own risk and such activities can result in personal injury, death and disability or property damage and loss (collectively “Damages”). We know that the risks, hazards and dangers include, but are not limited to, being hit by other participants, balls, bats and other training and playing objects; tripping and falling over uneven surfaces, tripping and falling over bases and pitcher mounds; colliding with or running into the field, training floor, and court components; tripping over and falling over athletic training equipment (e.g., weights, bands, medicine balls); and colliding with or running into other participants, staff, personnel and spectators. We also understand that these risks, hazards and dangers are further increased when other persons, whether or not of the same level of experience or skill, are present at the same time and using the same facilities.

In consideration of utilizing and/or participating in the **DEVELOPING NOBLE ATHLETES LLC (DBA DNA Academy), and DNA PREP ACADEMY – CHATSWORTH LLC** (furthermore collectively “DNA”) sports and skill training program, athletic training programs, camps, and its events, activities and facilities, we the undersigned -Participant and Parent or Legal Guardian (collectively, “We”)- hereby acknowledge, understand and agree as follows:

- A. The undersigned Participant **RISKS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PARALYSIS, DISMEMBERMENT, DISABILITY AND DEATH, AND** while particular rules of the sport, skills, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, **THIS RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY DOES EXIST, AS WELL AS THE RISK OF DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF PROPERTY**
- B. **WE KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ANY AND ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERS, and assume full responsibility for my participation;**
- C. To wave any and all claims for Damages that we may have against DNA, its managers, employees, officers, directors, stockholders, associates, agents, contractors, volunteers, lessors, sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, facilities operators and owners, or any other person or company in any way associated with any of the foregoing;
- D. To release DNA, its managers, employees, officers, directors, stockholders, associates, agents, contractors, volunteers, lessors, sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, facilities operators and owners of the properties where the activities take place, or any other person or company associated with any of the foregoing from any and all liability for the Damages that we may suffer or incur, or that our next of kin may suffer, as a result of our participation in any activity while at or about the DNA facilities and/or participating in DNA programs, events, and activities;
- E. To hold harmless and indemnify DNA, its managers, employees, officers, directors, stockholders, associates, agents, contractors, volunteers, lessees, sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, facilities operators and owners of the properties where the activities are taking place, or any other person or company in any way associated with any of the foregoing, from any and all liability for the Damages to any third party, including other participants or spectators of DNA programs, facilities, events and activities, resulting from our participation in any activity while at or about DNA and/or participating in DNA facilities and/or participating in DNA programs, events and activities;

- F. To not bring or file any legal proceeding, including, but not limited to, any lawsuit, arbitration or administrative proceeding against DNA, its managers, employees, officers, directors, stockholders, associates, agents, contractors, volunteers, lessors, sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, facilities operators and owners, or any other person or company in any way associated with any of the foregoing, for or with respect to any claim, matter or thing waived, relinquished, released or discharged by us in this Agreement;
- G. We further agree that any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of this Agreement or the interpretation of this Agreement or any claimed damages shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of the American Arbitration Association, except to the extent modified below. DNA agrees to such arbitration. The place of arbitration shall be Los Angeles County, California. The award of the arbitrator (the "Award") shall be final and binding upon the parties and judgment upon the award may be entered by any court of competent jurisdiction. The arbitrator shall be required to determine all issues in accordance with substantive law of the State of California, with any issue concerning this Agreement, including, but not limited to, its interpretation, effect and/or enforceability to be heard and decided before all other issues. The rules of evidence applicable to proceedings at law in the state of California shall be applicable to the arbitration proceedings;
- H. We acknowledge that the Released Parties make no warranty with respect to the equipment or other products furnished at the DNA facilities, events and activities, whether expressed or implied, including, but not limited to an implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

NOTICE: BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT, WE AGREE TO HAVE ANY DISPUTE, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF THIS AGREEMENT, THE INTERPRETATION OF THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY DAMAGES DECIDED BY NEUTRAL ARBITRATION AND ARE GIVING UP THE RIGHT TO A JURY OR COURT TRIAL.

- I. We further agree that this Agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
- J. We further certify that the undersigned Participant has no medical condition that would cause participation in activities at or about DNA facilities, programs, activities and events to be potentially hazardous to his/her health. In addition, this Agreement shall constitute our authorization and permission to DNA and any doctor or medical personnel chosen by DNA to treat, care for, hospitalize, medicate or order surgery for any of us in the event of a medical emergency to any of us. We waive, relinquish, release and discharge DNA, its managers, employees, officers, directors, stockholders, associates, agents, contractors, volunteers, lessors, sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, facilities operators and owners, or any other person or company in any way associated with any of the foregoing, for any and all claims and liability in connection with such treatment, care, hospitalization, medication or surgery and further agree to pay for all of the same and hold DNA harmless and indemnify DNA with respect thereto.
- K. We further agree that DNA has the right to photograph and/or videotape the undersigned Participant and further to display, use and/or otherwise use the Participants name, face, likeness, voice, and appearance forever and throughout the world, in all media, whether now known or hereafter devised, throughout the universe in perpetuity (including, without limitation, in online webcasts, on television, in motion pictures, films, newspapers, and magazines) and in all forms including, without limitation, digitized images, whether for advertising, publicity, or promotional purposes without compensation, reservation or limitation, or further approval, and we agree to hold harmless DNA for any claims associated with such grant and right to use.
